

Coach Expectations

All members of the NYSA/Oklahoma Celtic coaching staff are to see themselves as role models and ambassadors for the Club. We ask that our coaches be aware of how they represent themselves, their team, and NYSA/Oklahoma Celtic. It is imperative that our coaches are respectful to all around them including parents, opposing teams, and referees. We expect our coaches to exhibit professional behavior at all times, both on and off the field. Disciplinary action will be taken against any member of the coaching staff whose actions bring the Club into disrepute.

NYSA/Oklahoma Celtic has a zero-tolerance policy regarding aggressive coach sideline behavior. We encourage that positive reinforcement is provided to our players by coaches and sideline spectators. Coaches will be removed from the program for consistent violations of this philosophy. There should be no negative interactions between coaches and referees, coaches and opposing coaches/players, or coaches and visiting parents.

NYSA/Oklahoma Celtic coaches should aspire to be experts in player development and seek feedback and education, both formal and informal. We provide a variety of educational opportunities and resources for our coaches to help our coaches be the best they can be. We ask that our coaches prepare for training by reviewing the session and curriculum materials provided.

NYSA/Oklahoma Celtic coaches must embrace the Club philosophy and take pride in the development of each individual player assigned to them. We are committed to building a consistent style of play and coaching methodologies across our programming with the help of our dedicated coaches.
